## UPCOMING MEETINGS AND REMINDERS



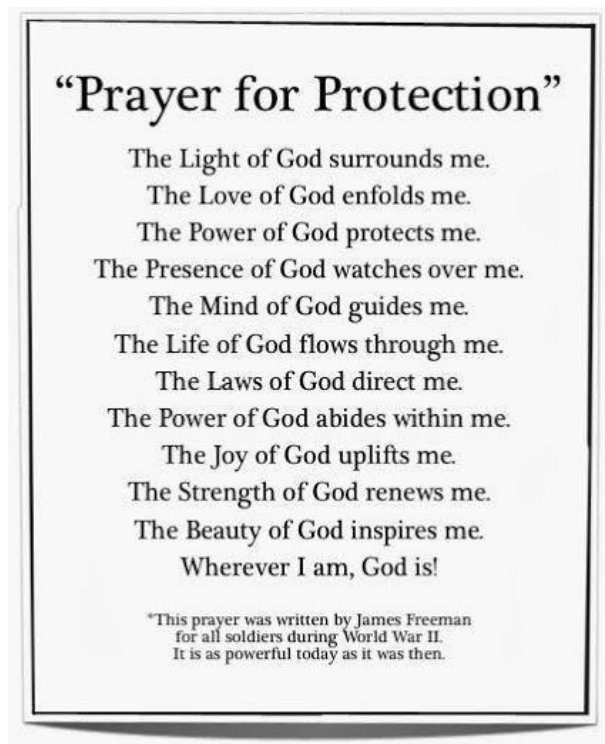
**Sunday, April 21<sup>st</sup>**- Annual Meeting after the service
