Moderator’s Advent Message 2021

Transcript of Videotaped Message

Grace and peace to you, in Jesus’ name. I’m Richard Bott, Moderator of The United Church of Canada.

Happy New Year! In much of the Christian church, Advent is the season that starts off the new liturgical year. We begin, again, to prepare ourselves to tell the story of the coming of the Christ-child.

As the number of hours that the daylight shines become fewer and fewer, here in Canada and in the rest of the northern hemisphere, much of *our* getting ready is done under the night sky. Sometimes the stars are shining brightly, and sometimes the cloud cover is thick, and sometimes snow or hail or rain is falling as we get ready. But we still get ready. In little ways, in big ways we still get ready for that moment when we stand in the stable, with all of Jesus’ disciples through the ages, in no little amount of awe and wonder, and realize what this child is going to do that will change the world: God’s presence embodied, who will turn the world on its head, over and over and over again. Perhaps it’s *not* so strange that we still get ready, no matter what is going on around us. Here in Canada, and in many of the richer parts of the world, our populations are able to celebrate the various winter festivals with families and friends coming together, safer because of the vaccines against COVID-19. But that’s not true everywhere. There are many people around the world who have not yet had the opportunity to be vaccinated because the vaccines aren’t getting to them. I wonder if part of the way that we could get ready for the celebration of abundant life in Jesus’ birth might be to share the resources and the voices we have to make sure that every elder, every adult, every teen, every child would have access to the vaccines, all around God’s world.

Perhaps, in this small way, our Advent preparations might help the light of Christ’s love to shine in the night’s sky in a way that that love can be felt, no matter how thick the clouds may seem.

Blessed Advent, friends. I look forward to meeting you when we gather at the stable. Until then, I wish you times when you can go deep into your spirituality, times when you can be bold in your discipleship, times when you can be daring in your justice-seeking and justice-living!
